Dear parents, dear student,

thank you for your interest in the Dreilinden-Gymnasium. We have the following profiles on offer:

- a) STEM science technology engineering mathematics
- b) FLEX a mixed and more flexible combination of both
- c) BILI bilingual (English / German)
- e) SESB a European State school class

This leaflet aims to inform about our selection procedure and also serves for you as a priority list.

In the case of excess demand, we assign 10% of the applications to special cases of hardship, 60% depending on the primary school assessment and the remaining 30% will be decided by drawing lots.

In accordance with our local district, we are planning to start with 4 new classes year 7. One of them will be a European State school class (German / English).

In case there will be more applications than actually available places there is a special procedure to allot the places:

- Up to 10% of available places will be allotted to cases of hardship.
- At least 60% of available places will be given to students depending on their average primary school grades.
- 30% will be decided by lot.

With your first choice you choose this school as a whole with all three profiles.

Then you can rank the different profiles according to your priority choice:

Priority 1 ► highest

Priority 2 ► less

Priority 3 ► least

Application procedure for SESB is a separate process. You can put it as highest priority and additionally one of the three profile classes or vice versa.

In case of excess demand because of first priorities, only first priorities will be considered.

Putting together the classes

Distribution of students into the different classes depends on their primary school grades.

Additionally, they determine the order of priority for class assignments (see reverse).

Students with better grades get their highest priority choice if that is possible. If the class is already full with higher achieving students, the next priority choice becomes relevant. Final class composition will follow needs of internal school organisation demands.

b	FLEX	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ In 7th grade additional lessons in English and Biology, later in English and electives ▪ In grades 8 to 10 the students choose two electives per year. If the electives are in English throughout these years the students will be considered bilingual. Starting in 9th grade, these courses have to be "politics" and "natural science". Other students choose – when belonging to the math / science profile – two of their 6 electives from the science or other pool. 	
c	BILI	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Additional hours in English, in total 5 ▪ Starting with 8th grade students have more subjects taught in English: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ 8: Geography (2 lessons) ▪ 9 and 10: Geography and Biology (2 and 3 lessons) ▪ Students have to choose at least one elective in English in grades 8, 9 and 10 (e.g. Law, History) 	

There is a special procedure for SESB applications: it has to be noted as a single wish on your application form (hologram-sheet). SESB primary students with "Gymnasialprognose" will be taken first. All other applicants will be tested thoroughly in a 60-minute-test (written and oral) "Sprachstandserhebungsverfahren" to assess if their language abilities are sufficient.
